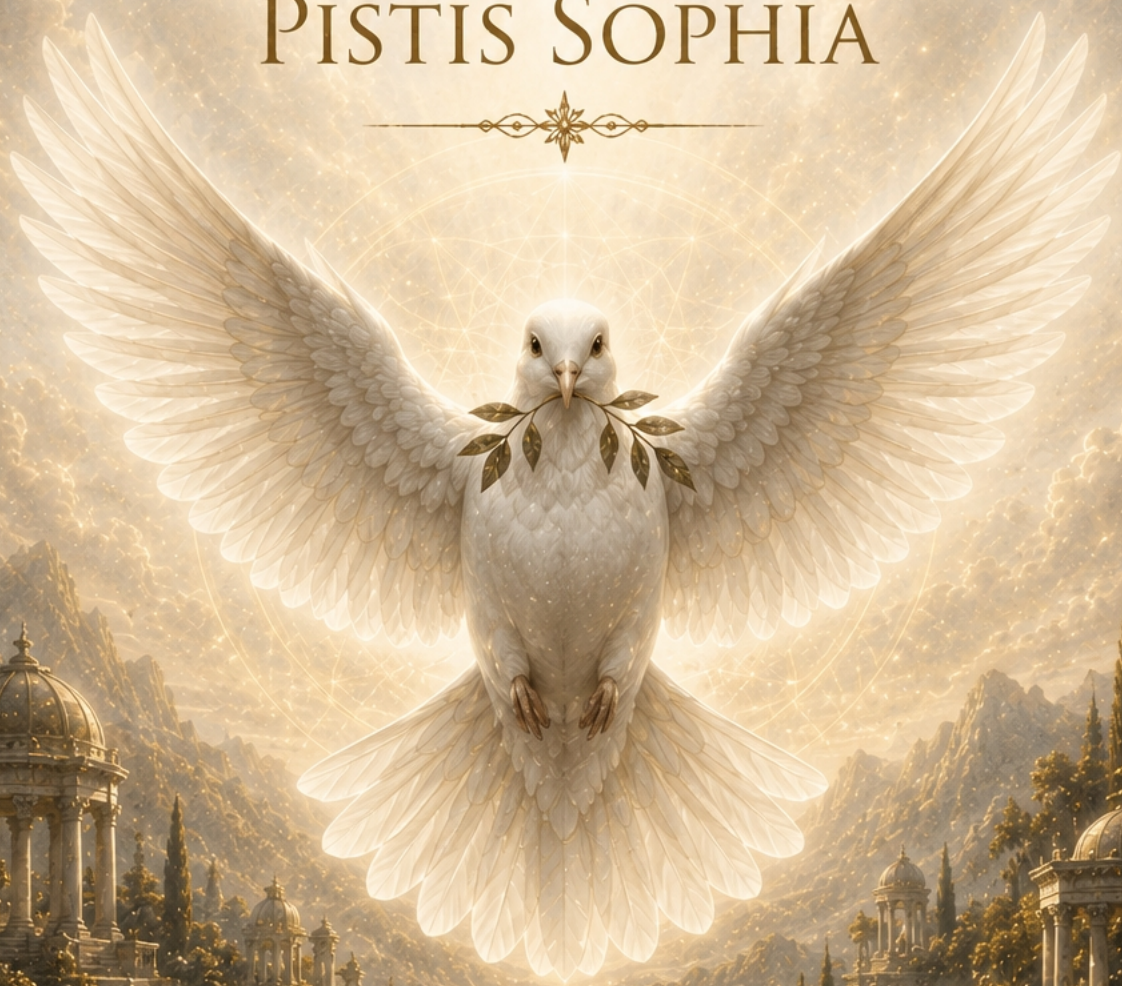

Movement II — Book I

The Recognition Beyond Ascent
